#### An Elder Writes ....

I write this on the day after the combined Service at St David's Uniting Church led by Clare Nutbrown-Hughes.

Making an impact at every one of four churches will not be an easy task for a newly ordained minister but I am reminded of the problems Paul had with his churches.

Thankfully, none of the churches in our Pastorate has a disreputable image for a new minister to contend with! On the contrary, I would expect a great deal of support and encouragement from all four churches.

Turning to world affairs the news is grim. Open warfare is rife. A lasting, just peace seems far away as long as ruthless aggressors hold power. Christians are persecuted and killed in Africa and the middle east.

In darkest days we do well to remember God's covenant with us. To remember from Jesus,

'I am with you always even until the end of the world'.

Let us look forward to Easter Day when the Easter Acclamation may ring out again -

Alleluia Christ is risen!
